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Question 1: “Who was The First Catholic Martyr?”

Question 5: “What did those who hated those who saw The Truth of Jesus do?”

Answer: “*But they cried out in a loud voice, covered their ears, and rushed upon him together. They threw him out of the city, and began to stone him. The witnesses laid down their cloaks at the feet of a young man named Saul.*”

Question 6: “What were some of ‘The Last Words’ spoken on earth by St. Stephen, The First Catholic Martyr?”

Answer: “*As they were stoning Stephen, he called out ‘Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.’*”

Question 7: “Did St. Stephen think of those ‘Final Words’ by himself?”

Answer: “Jesus answers that question in Mt. 10:17:22. *‘When they hand you over, do not worry about how you are to speak or what you are to say. You will be given at that moment what you are to say. For it will not be you who speak, but the Spirit of your Father speaking through you.’*”

Every Catholic prays that “The Spirit of The Father” will lead us to have our “last words” on earth begin with: “Lord Jesus, receive my spirit.”

Question 3: “Why do Willful Protestants refuse to ‘keep that commandment’ of Jesus and have ‘life’ in them?”

Answer: “The only people who can provide That Holy Food are Catholic priests. Willful Protestants do not ‘keep’ themselves in obedience to The Church Jesus Spoke Into Being whose priests have The Power to provide That Holy Food through The Catholic Miracle of Transubstantiation:

‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’”

St. John describes those who let God save us from being ‘victimized’ by those overcome by pride, envy, greed, gluttony, anger, lust, and sloth. Today’s Reading from 1 John 2:12-17 is God’s Wisdom in human words:

*I am writing to you, children,
because your sins have been forgiven for His name’s sake.*

*I am writing to you, fathers,
because you know Him Who is from the beginning.*

*I am writing to you, young men,
because you have conquered the Evil One.*

*I write to you, children,
because you know The Father.*

*I write to you, fathers,
because you know Him Who is from the beginning.*

*I write to you, young men,
because you are strong and the word of God remains in you, and you have conquered the Evil One.*

St. John is describing those blessed to resist being ‘victimized’ by ‘worldly concerns’.”

Question 2: “How can we keep our souls being ‘victimized’ and spend eternity being tormented by vicious demons of pride, envy, greed, gluttony, anger, lust, and sloth?”

Answer: “St. John tells us! *‘Do not love the world or the things of the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of The Father is not in him.’*”

Question 3: “Does St. John tell us how to identify the demons who want to make us ‘victims’ of evil?”

Answer: “*‘For all that is in the world, sensual lust, enticement for the eyes, and a pretentious life, is not from the Father but is from the world.’*”

Question 4: “Does That Short Sentence describe every evil that draws us away from God?”

Answer: “That Short Sentence, 1 John 1:16, is one of the most brilliantly inclusive descriptions in History. It should be memorized and repeated at every temptation we meet.”

Question 5: “What are Catholics blessed to learn from That Short Sentence?”

Answer: “Every Catholic is guided by The Simple Truth that follows! ‘Yet the world and its enticement are passing away.’”

Question 6: “What keeps Catholics from being ‘victimized’ by ‘worldly enticements’?”

Answer: “Catholics are guided by connecting This Word from St. John: *‘But whoever does the will of God remains forever.’* with This Word from He Who Fulfilled The Prophecies!

‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’”

Question 7: “What keeps people from being in The Only Church Spoken Into Being by That Word from God?”


Answer: “They let themselves be ‘victimized’ by demons who lead them to believe: ‘I know more than God about getting my soul into Heaven.’”

Question 1: “Do God and Abraham agree that the most important thing children can have is God’s Love?”

Answer: “Every child’s soul will live forever. All other gifts from God will disappear. Abraham knew that, and asked God: *‘O Lord God, what good will Your gifts be, if I keep on being childless . . .?’*”

Question 2: “What do the best Catholics do?”

Answer: “The best Catholics become priests and religious! They encourage all to heed the examples of God and Mary to have and properly raise children so more immortal souls may be with them and God, forever in Heaven.”

Question 3: “What examples of parenthood do good Catholics follow?”

Answer: “Luke 2:22-40 tell us the duties of Catholic parents shown by Mary and Joseph!

‘When they had fulfilled all the prescriptions of the Law of the Lord, they returned to Galilee, to their own town of Nazareth. The child grew and became strong, filled with wisdom; and the favor of God was upon him.’”

Question 4: “Does ‘the favor of God come upon’ every child who is raised to follow Teachings of The Only Church Spoken Into Being by This Word of Jesus Christ, The Son of God and His Blessed Mother, Mary?”

'And I say unto you thou art Jesus and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.'

Question 1: “How does God make Catholics different?”

Answer: “Catholics see that God used Moses to make the DNA of His Chosen People different in Numbers 6:22-27. ‘This is how you shall bless the Israelites. Say to them: The Lord bless you and keep you! The Lord let his face shine upon you, and be gracious to you! The Lord look upon you kindly and give you peace! So shall they invoke My Name upon the Israelites, and I will bless them.’”

Question 2: “How does God make Catholics different from other people, today?”

Answer: “St. Paul’s Letter to the Galatians 4:4-7 explains: *‘Brothers and sisters: when the fullness of time had come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under the law, to ransom those under the law, so that we might receive adoption as sons. As proof that you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, crying out, ‘Abba, Father!’*”

Then, God told us about The Miraculous DNA change that turns Catholics into His ‘heirs’: *‘So you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son then also an heir, through God.’*”

Question 3: “Does being a Catholic change our DNA enough to make us a ‘child of God’?”

Answer: “Only Catholics are able to be transformed by Catholic Communion that Jesus provides His Church to give us ‘life’! He told us 14 times *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’*”

Question 4: “Does That Holy Food actually change Catholic DNA?”

Answer: “Yes! Receiving His Body and Blood actually changes our DNA to let God live in us and make us His ‘heirs’.”

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Question 5: “What happens when a Catholic stops receiving That Holy Food?”

Answer: “We no longer have His ‘life’ replenished within us. Sin enters, and we fall farther from God.”

Question 6: “Does God give us a way to restore the ‘Holy Electrons’ that make Catholics different from others?”

Answer: “His Catholic priests are empowered to provide Absolution after we Confess our sins to them. That allows our DNA return to having His ‘life’ within us.”

Answer: “James 1:18 is as clear as it needs to be: *‘By His own choice He made us His children by the message of the truth so that we should be a sort of first-fruits of all that He had created.’*

Only those who become ‘children’ of Jesus by meaningfully heeding His ‘message of truth’ can be saved.”

~

Question 4: “The Great Gift of our life has taken form according to God’s Blueprint in our DNA. If we do not live by Words of God, can we go to His Judgment among His legitimate ‘children’?”

Answer. “Only His legitimate ‘children’ can be among His ‘heirs’. That is why Catholics strive to keep the blessed and unique form of DNA that has taken form in us among *‘You are My friends if you obey My commands.’*”

~

Question 5: “What Word of Jesus do His Catholic ‘children’ strive to obey?”

Answer: “Catholics are blessed to honor This Word of Jesus more than any human teaching: *‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’*”

~

Question 6: “Do other Words of God tell us to be among His obedient, Catholic ‘children’?”

Answer: “1 John 2:22-28 includes This Instruction to His ‘children’: *‘And now, children, remain in Him, so that when He appears we may have confidence and not be put to shame by Him at His coming.’*”

Every person on earth has received our great gift of life in the blessed and utterly unique DNA Program that God blessed to become each one of us. God’s ‘children’ strive to honor Every Word of His Son.

God’s ‘children’ will inherit ‘the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven’ that He left to His One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic Church.

Jesus told us how we could go to Judgment and be among “The Children of God”.

Question 1: “Can every person on earth become ‘children of God’?”

Answer: “1 John 2:29-3:6 is clear: *‘If you consider that God is righteous, you also know that everyone who acts in righteousness is begotten by Him. See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called the children of God. Yet so we are.’*”

Question 2: “Can we ‘act in righteousness’ if we willfully choose to disobey Any Teaching of God?”

Answer: “God’s most ‘beloved Disciple’ tells us in John 1:12-14: *‘The Word of God became flesh and dwelt among us. To those who accepted Him He gave power to become the children of God.’*”

Question 3: “How do we know that we have most meaningfully ‘accepted Him’?”

Answer: “His beloved ‘children’ all ‘accept’ The Call to Catholic Communion that Jesus repeated 14 times! *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’*”

Question 4: “Are we changed by having His ‘life in us’ in the form of His ‘flesh’ provided by His priests at Catholic Communion?”

Answer: “Catholics receive the actual Body and Blood of Jesus Christ in Catholic Communion. We have His ‘Life’ in us. Receiving That Holy Food lets us become one of ‘God’s children’.”

Question 5: “Is it possible for anyone to become a ‘child of God’ while willfully and knowingly disobeying Any Word of God in The Bible?”

Answer: “The more Words of God we obey, the more we become ‘children of God’.”

Question 6: “When we become ‘God’s children’, how do we change?”

Answer: “We become closer to our Father! ‘Everyone who has this hope based on Him makes himself pure, as He is pure. Everyone who commits sin commits lawlessness, for sin is lawlessness.’”

May all be blessed to understand! “You know that He was revealed to take away sins, and in Him there is no sin. No one who remains in Him sins; no one who sins has seen Him or known Him.”

May all be blessed to receive Catholic Communion so that we may be “children of God”.

St. John is the most “Beloved Disciple”. God’s love for St. John let him make things clear!

Question 1: “Who are ‘the first kind of people’ identified by Jesus?”

Answer: “1 John 3-7 tells us that “One Kind of People” is ‘deceived’:

‘Children, let no one deceive you. The person who acts in righteousness is righteous, just as He (God) is righteous.’”

Question 2: “Who is the ‘Other Kind of People’?”

Answer: “*The ‘other Kind of People’ let themselves be ‘deceived’! Jesus describes them: ‘Whoever sins belongs to the Devil, because the Devil has sinned from the beginning.’”*

Question 3: “Why did Jesus Christ, The Second Person of The Holy Trinity, take form on earth to tell us of ‘the Two Kinds of People’?”

Answer: “Jesus answers that! ‘Indeed, the Son of God was revealed to destroy the works of the Devil.’”

~

Question 4: “Does this connect to the essence of the DNA that formed us in our Mother’s womb when we were smaller than a grain of salt at our conception?”

Answer: “God’s ‘kind of people’ are clearly identified by Jesus: *‘No one who is begotten by God commits sin, because God’s seed remains in him; he cannot sin because he is begotten by God.’”*

Question 5: “How can we be among those who are ‘begotten by God?’”

Answer: “Our mind and body become ‘begotten by God’ when we obey The The Call to Catholic Communion that Jesus repeated 14 times: *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’*”

Question 6: “What makes ‘Catholic Communion’ so important?”

Question 2: "Why did Cain 'slaughter' his brother?"

Answer: "*'Because his own works were evil, and those of his brother were righteous. Do not be amazed, then, brothers and sisters, if the world hates you.'*"

Question 3: "Why do worldly people hate all who strive to obey Teachings of God?"

Answer: "'We know that we have passed from death to life because we love our brothers. Whoever does not love (their brothers) remains in death.'"

~

Question 4: "What do the people who 'hate their brothers' become?"

Answer: "'Everyone who hates his brother is a murderer, and you know that no murderer has eternal life remaining in him.'"

~

Question 5: "How can we keep our souls from going to God's Judgment as a 'murderer'?"

Answer: “*The way we came to know love was that He laid down His life for us; so we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.*”

~

Question 6: “Who are our ‘brothers’?”

Answer: “This Catholic Teaching answers that question in one sentence! *‘Life must be protected from conception until natural death.’*”

~

Question 7: “How can we make that a part of our lives so that our soul may go to Judgment and get into Heaven?”

Answer: “*‘If someone who has worldly means sees a brother in need and refuses him compassion, how can the love of God remain in him? Children, let us love not in word or speech but in deed and truth.’* Catholics try to help all our ‘brothers’, including those yet to be born.”

Question 8: “Does St. John make all of that clear?”

Answer: “*‘Now this is how we shall know that we belong to the truth and reassure our hearts before Him in whatever our hearts condemn, for God is greater than our hearts and knows everything.’*”

Question 9: “Does it help to be Catholic?”

Answer: “Christians are blessed as we let our Love of God and our brothers lead us into The Church Spoken Into Being by This Word of Jesus: ‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.’

Catholics know: ‘Beloved, if our hearts do not condemn us, we have confidence in God.’”

Question 10: “What lets Catholics have ‘confidence in God’?”

Answer: “Jesus gave His Life to so that all who would be Catholics could get ‘the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’ that He died in agony to leave to One Church on earth!”

Question 1: "Who are the only people specifically named as 'victors over the world'?"

Answer: "Those among God's 'Beloved'! 'Beloved: Who indeed is the victor over the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?'"

Question 2: "Why do God's 'Beloved people' believe that?"

Answer: "The Bible tells us that God's 'Beloved people' Think Clearly enough to realize: *'This is the one who came through water and Blood, Jesus Christ, not by water alone, but by water and Blood. The Spirit is the one who testifies, and the Spirit is truth.'*"

~

Question 3: "Does The Catholic Teaching about The Holy Trinity let us learn that?"

Answer: "*'So there are Three that testify, the Spirit, the Water, and the Blood, and The Three are of one accord.'*"

~

Question 4: "Why should we believe that?"

Answer: "*'If we accept human testimony, the testimony of God is surely greater. Now the testimony of God is this, that He has testified on behalf of His Son.'*"

~

Question 5: "What do those who meaningfully believe in Jesus gain?"

Answer: “We gain ‘eternal life’ in Heaven’! *‘Whoever believes in the Son of God has this testimony within himself. Whoever does not believe God has made Him a liar by not believing the testimony God has given about his Son.’*”

~

Question 6: “What is ‘the testimony God has given about His Son’?”

Answer: “*“And this is the testimony: God gave us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. Whoever possesses the Son has life . . .”*

~

Question 7: “Do all of God’s Teachings for the past 4,000 years take form in The Call to Catholic Communion that His Son repeated 14 times: *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’*?”

Answer: “The ‘Most Beloved Disciple’ is clear! *‘whoever does not possess the Son of God does not have life.’* If we reject The Only Church Spoken Into Being by This Word of The Son, we keep ourselves from having ‘God’s life’ in us:

The Ten Northern Tribes then spread from The Philippines to Ireland! Those who remained in what is now Iran, Iraq, Syria, Armenia, and Turkey grew into cities and nations. They came together in The Parthian Empire around 250 BC. They ruled Babylon for the next 500 years.”

Question 3: “Why does The Bible tell us in Mt. 2:1-12 that ‘King Herod and all of Jerusalem were greatly troubled’ when The Magi arrived from Parthia?”

Answer: “Before the Romans, Parthia ruled much of Israel! Roman officials in Jerusalem were worried about The Parthians returning. They wanted to be sure Herod would not help them. That’s why ‘everyone was greatly troubled’. Those Magi were not just three men on camels! They may have had a battalion or two of armed troops escorting them and the valuable ‘gold, frankincense, and mhyrr’ they were bringing to The Messiah.”

~

Question 4: “How did The Three Wise Men, ‘The Magi’, know that The Birth of The Messiah was coming?”

Answer: “The Babylonians in Parthia knew more about astronomy than anyone! Studying two or three thousand years of written records of planet and star movements told them something very unusual was about to happen.

Jewish people in Babylon told The Magi their Prophets had predicted that God’s Messiah would come to earth.

The Magi connected Jewish Prophecies with astronomical facts. Three of them took their gifts and guards and spent a few months going to Jerusalem. There, these important officials were quickly brought to meet with King Herod.”

~

Question 5: “What did Herod do?”

Answer: “He had Jewish Scholars tell them where The Prophet Micah, (5:1-2), predicted The Messiah would take Human Form on earth: ‘The Messiah will be born in Bethlehem.’

Today’s Reading from Isaiah 60:1-6 reminds us of another Prophecy about Jesus that came true at Epiphany! “Caravans of camels shall fill you, dromedaries from Midian and Ephah; all from Sheba shall come bearing gold and frankincense, and proclaiming the praises of the LORD.”

~

Question 6: What did Herod do after that?”


Answer: “Herod told The Perpetual Political Lie! He publicly proclaimed to honor Truth! ‘Go and search diligently for the child and when you have found Him, bring me word, so I, too may go and do Him homage.’ A short time later, he brutally murdered every boy in Bethlehem under the age of two.”

The “Wise Men”, the Parthian Magistrates, left Catholics that lesson about life and politics. Many minds, families, and nations are controlled by Herods who claim to honor truth while attacking all who believe This Word from He Who Is Truth at every opportunity!

“And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.”

Answer: “God tells us He will never give us more than we can do! *‘And His commandments are not burdensome, for whoever is begotten by God conquers the world.’”*

Question 4: “How can we believe it is possible for any of us to ‘conquer the world?’”

Answer: “St. John explains: *‘And the victory that conquers the world is our faith. Who indeed is the victor over the world but the one who believes that Jesus is the Son of God?’”*

~

Question 5: “What lets Catholics ‘believe’ enough to obey The Church-Creating Word of Jesus Christ: ‘And I say unto you, thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’“?

Answer: “Catholics know that The Father and Holy Spirit want us to obey Every Word of The Son:

‘This is the one who came through water and blood, Jesus Christ, not by water alone, but by water and blood. The Spirit is the one who testifies, and the Spirit is truth. So there are three that testify, the Spirit, the water, and the blood, and the three are of one accord.’”

~

Question 6: “What makes Catholics reject Willful Protestant ideas that contradict Any Word of Jesus?”

Answer: “This Truth identifies every Willful Protestant who prefer self-serving human teachings! *‘If we accept human testimony, the testimony of God is surely greater. Now the testimony of God is this, that He has testified on behalf of His Son.’”*

Question 7: What more does anyone who Thinks Clearly need to know to “Be Catholic”?”

Answer: “God’s Words tell us all we need to know.”

Answer: “First, demons can make the people they control speak for them. *‘In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit (a demon). He cried out, ‘What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have You come to destroy us? I know who You are, the Holy One of God!’*”

~

Question 3: “What did Jesus tell the demon who was speaking through the person it possessed?”

Answer: “Jesus spoke directly to the demon: ‘Jesus rebuked him’! Then, Jesus gave the demon a Direct Order to show His Authority over demons! ‘He said: Quiet! Come out of him!’”

~

Question 3: “Did the demon then speak for itself?”

Answer: “*The demon gave voice to the anguish of being sent to hell with the other demons! ‘The unclean spirit convulsed him and with a loud cry came out of him.’*”

~

Question 4: “What do we learn from what Jesus did to the demon?”

Answer: “We learn that demons hate for the minds of people they possess to hear Words of Jesus!”

~

Question 5: “Do demons hate those who encourage obedience to Words of Jesus?”

Answer: “The more obedient we are to Words of Jesus, the more they hate us.”

~

Question 6: “Whom do demons hate the most?”

Answer: “They hate Catholic priests!”

~

Question 7: “Why do demons hate Catholic priests more than anyone on earth?”

Answer: “Catholic priests are Ordained by God with The Power to turn bread and wine into the actual Body and Blood of Jesus Christ! Those who receive That Holy Food at the hands of Catholic priests obey The Call to Catholic Communion that Jesus repeated 14 times: *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’*”

~

Question 8: “Do demons hate those who receive ‘life’ from That Holy Food?”

Answer: “Demons hate Catholics more than they hate those who believe only some Words of Jesus.”

Question 9: “What word of Jesus makes demons hate Catholics so much?”

Answer: “Demons hate anyone who respects Jesus enough to live by This Church-Creating Word from Him:

‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’”

Jesus died to give us ‘the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven’. They are His Way to escape the temptations of demons who want our souls to be tortured by them in hell.

Question 1: “What words did Eli tell Samuel that we should all say to God?”

Answer: “1 Samuel 3:1-20 tells us that while Samuel ‘was sleeping in The Temple of The Lord where The Ark of God was.’, The Lord called to Samuel, who answered ‘Here I am.’” Three times, Samuel got up and went to Eli. The third time, Eli realized that God was calling Samuel.”

~

Question 2: “Did Eli tell Samuel what to say if God called to him again?”

Answer: “Eli told Samuel to answer God by saying: ‘Speak Lord, for your servant is listening.’”

~

Question 3: “Why is that important for us, today?”

Answer: “God speaks to each of us. May we all be blessed answer God by saying: ‘Speak Lord, for Your servant is listening.’”

~

Question 4: “Why is that so important?”

Answer: “It shows that we meaningfully know that God has The Power to speak to us!”

~

Question 5: “What else should we do?”

Answer: “We must recognize that our proper place is to be among the ‘servants’ who will meaningfully ‘listen’ to Him.”

~

Question 6: “What did God do for Samuel when he became God’s obedient ‘servant’?”

Answer: “*Samuel grew up, and The Lord was with him, not permitting any word of His to be without effect. Thus all Israel from Dan to Beersheba came to know that Samuel was an accredited prophet of The Lord.*”

~

Question 7: “Does The Bible tell us in other places that we should obey The Lord?”

Answer: “Today’s Psalms, 40:2-10 tell us what God’s ‘servants’ do! This Response follows every Psalm: “Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.”

‘I have waited, waited for The Lord and He stooped toward me and heard my cry. Blessed the man who makes The Lord his trust; who turns not to idolatry or to those who stray after falsehood.

Sacrifice or oblation You wished not, but ears open to obedience You gave me. Burnt offerings or sin-offerings You sought not; then I said to God: ‘Behold I come.’

In the written scroll it is prescribed for me. To do Your will, O my God, is my delight, and Your law is within my heart!

I announced Your justice in the vast assembly; I did not restrain my lips, as You, O Lord, know.’

Catholics strive to live by what Eli told Samuel to say to God: ‘Here am I, Lord; I come to do your will.’”

~

Question 8: “How do we ‘listen’ to God, today?”

Answer: “We ‘listen’ to Words of His Son so we may be among those described in John 10:27!

‘My sheep hear My voice, says The Lord. I know them, and they follow Me.’”

~

May all be blessed to ‘hear’ this Word of His and be among the “listeners” who “follow” Him to “the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven” that He died to leave on earth!

“And I say unto you, thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.”

Jesus even cured the diseases of greed and gluttony among some people

Question 1: “This Passage from Mt. 4:23 is staggering. ‘*Jesus preached the Gospel of the Kingdom and cured every disease among the people*’. Can that be true?”

~

Question 2: “We know that Every Word of He Who Fulfilled The Prophecies is Truth! Jesus actually did provide a ‘*cure every disease among the people*’.”

~

Question 3: “Do all ‘the people’ take advantage of His Power to ‘cure every disease’?”

Answer: “‘Every’ person does not want to recognize or ‘cure every disease’ that infects their minds and souls.”

~

Question 4: “Which group of people are the hardest to ‘cure’?”

Answer: “Most rich people in Jerusalem hated Jesus. Some of them got groups they controlled to kill Him and His many of His followers. They did not want to be ‘cured of any disease’ that drove them to spend their lives getting more.”

~

Question 5: “What causes people to be greedy gluttons?”

Answer: “Each of them refuses to Think Clearly about what happens to their immortal soul when it goes to God’s Judgment.”

~

Question 6: “What do greedy gluttons like to think about?”

Answer: “Taking more from their neighbors.”

~

Question 7: “What happens when their neighbors run out of money?”

Answer: “First, they take as much as they can from foreign nations. When that runs out, the greediest gluttons focus on borrowing money, often with “bond issues” for largely useless projects. They make their neighbors pay the highest possible interest on what they force them to borrow. Each generation of greedy gluttons keeps future generations of their neighbors from being born.”

~

Question 9: “Did Jesus leave a cure for greed and gluttony that makes neighbors too poor to raise children in happy families?”

Answer: “This Word of Jesus is the best cure for greed, gluttony, and every ‘disease’ of the mind and soul: ‘Love God and love your neighbors as yourself.’”

~


Question 10: “What ‘cure’ did Jesus leave The Catholic Church He gave His Life to Speak Into Being: ‘Thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’”

Answer: “Every Catholic knows: “‘I will lose my soul if I do to my neighbors what I do not want them to do to me!’ That knowledge helps us cure greed, gluttony, and every sin there is.”

“Jesus preached the Gospel of the Kingdom and cured every disease among the people.”

Question 3: “Why did some people choose to reject ‘God as their King’?”

Answer: “Pride is the driving sin of all who want to make themselves into earthly ‘kings’. Pride also drives all who want to profit from earthly rulers: *‘They are acting toward you just as they have acted from the day I brought them up from Egypt to this very day, deserting Me to serve other gods.’*”

~

Question 4: “Did God warn them that ‘kings’ and their ‘officials’ always do everything they can to turn free people into slaves?”

Answer: “God warned them in verses 10-17! *‘He will make your children into slaves, steal your best fields, vineyards, olive groves, crops, grape harvests, male and female slaves, your best oxen and donkeys, tithe your flocks, and make you into slaves to him and his officials.’*”

Then, God gave This Prophecy to every person on earth who would soon see the results of ‘rejecting God’: *‘On that day you will cry out because of the king whom you have chosen, but The Lord will not answer you on that day.’*

When they realize what they have lost, people in every nation on earth for 3,000 years have been ‘crying out’ in regret of what their ‘kings’ are doing to them. That Prophecy from God still comes true throughout the earth.”

Question 5: “Is there any way people can find relief from worldly ‘kings’?”

Answer: “They can do what worldly ‘kings’ hate for them to do! They may find ‘the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven’. God Spoke His Earthly Kingdom into Being with The Church-Creating Word of His Son:


‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of God.’!”

Answer: “We will all be ‘raised’ at God’s Final Judgment! Rev. 20:12 is clear. *‘I saw the dead, both great and small, standing in front of His Throne., while The Book of Life was opened and other books opened which were the record of what they had done in their lives, by which the dead were judged.’*”

Question 3: “Do those ‘Books of Life’ tell God how much we have helped or hurt our neighbors by our words and deeds on earth?”

Answer: “1 Corinthians 6:9-11 is clear: *‘You know perfectly well that people who do wrong will not inherit The Kingdom of God: people of immoral lives, idolators, adulterers, catamites, sodomites, thieves, usurers, drunkards, slanderers and swindlers will never inherit The Kingdom of God.’*”

Question 4: “Does St. Paul tell us how we should use our bodies?”

Answer: “*Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? But whoever is joined to the Lord becomes one Spirit with him.*’ Then, St Paul gives us Two Words to guide the way we should use our bodies: ‘Avoid immorality.’”

Question 5: “What happens to our soul if our ‘Book of Life’ shows that we have chosen to do more harm than good to our ourselves and our neighbors by choosing to ‘Accept Immorality’?”

Answer: “Rev. 20: *Then, death and hell were thrown into the burning lake. This burning lake is the second death. Anyone whose name could not be found in The Book of Life was thrown into the burning lake.*”

Question 5: “We have all sinned! What can we do to get our soul into Heaven?”

Answer: “St. Faustina tells us that Jesus will forgive even the greatest sinners! The safest thing we can do is confess our sins and ask for His Mercy.”

May we be blessed to ‘Avoid Immorality’.

Forever!

“Upright” is two words in one. No one is more “upright” than Jesus on The Cross.

Question 1: “Where does God tell us to focus on fighting evil?”

Answer: “In Today’s Reading, 1 Sm 15:16-23, God gave King Saul This Instruction: *‘Go and put the sinful Amalekites under a ban of destruction. Fight against them until you have exterminated them.’*”

Question 2: “Did King Saul obey God?”

Answer: “Saul did not ‘exterminate’ what the evil Amalekites had. *‘But from the spoil the men took sheep and oxen, the best of what had been banned, to sacrifice to The Lord their God in Gilgal.’*”

God made it clear that obeying Him was more important than sacrifice. *‘Obedience is better than sacrifice, and submission than the fat of rams. For a sin like divination is rebellion, and presumption is the crime of idolatry. Because you have rejected the command of The Lord, He has rejected you as ruler.’*”

Question 3: “What kind of people will choose to obey God instead of doing what they want?”

Answer: “Today’s Psalm 50:8-23, tells us who is pleasing to God! *‘To the upright I will show the saving power of God. He that offers praise as a sacrifice glorifies Me; and to him that goes the right way I will show the salvation of God.’*”

Question 4: “What do ‘upright’ people know?”

Answer: *“‘Upright’ is two words in one! ‘Upright’ people know how important it is to be ‘up’, close to God, and to be ‘right’ here on earth! That is what makes a person ‘upright’.”*

Question 5: “What are ‘upright’ people blessed to know?”

Answer: “‘Upright’ people are blessed to apply Hebrews 4:12 to our thoughts, words, and deeds. ‘The Word of God is living and effective, able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart.’”

Question 6: “What does That Word of God lead His Chosen People to do in every Age?”

Answer: “God’s Word to King Saul leads us to James 1:27. *‘Religion that God our Father accepts as pure and faultless is this: to look after orphans and widows in their distress and to keep oneself uncontaminated from the world.’*”

~


Question 7: Why is protecting ‘orphans’ so important to God?”

Answer: “‘Orphans’ include the helpless children who were sacrificed on the Altars of the Amelekites who worshiped Baal. God sent Saul to fight the Amelekites because He wanted those beliefs to be ‘destroyed’ and children protected.”

Some things never change. God’s ‘Chosen People’ choose to be ‘upright’. Others chose to be ‘downright wrong’.

Did God and His Prophet use deception to make a man a "King"?



Every Word of God and His Prophets is Truth.

Question 1: “When and how did God and His Prophet seem to use deception to make a man a King?”

Answer: “Samuel 16:1-13 includes God’s Direct Order to Samuel! *‘Fill your horn with oil, and be on your way. I am sending you to Jesse of Bethlehem, for I have chosen My king from among his sons.’*”

But Samuel replied: ‘How can I go? Saul will hear of it and kill me.’

To this The Lord answered: ‘Take a heifer along and say, ‘I have come to sacrifice to The Lord.’”

Question 2: “Was The Lord telling Samuel to ‘bear false witness’?”

Answer: “Only Catholics can answer that profound Question! Samuel was ‘making a Sacrifice to The Lord!’”

Question 3: “Didn’t God tell Samuel to ‘bear false witness ‘ by using ‘a heifer for a sacrifice’ as a lie to tell agents of Saul when he sent Samuel to ‘Jesse of Bethlehem’.”

Answer: “God was telling Samuel that He wanted him to make a specific ‘sacrifice’ to The Lord!”

Question 4: “What ‘sacrifice’ was Samuel preparing to ‘make to the Lord’?”

Answer: “Catholics can Think Clearly enough to understand! God was using Samuel to replace King Saul for his Willful Disobedience to God. He sent Samuel to Jesse of Bethlehem to ‘sacrifice’ The Kingship of Saul!”

Question 5: “Samuel actually was making a ‘sacrifice’?”

Answer: “Yes! The ‘heifer’ was used for ‘the Sacrificial Banquet’ when David arrived: *‘Send for him; we will not begin the sacrificial banquet until he arrives here.’*”

Catholics are bless to know: “Every Word of God and His Prophets is Truth!”

That is why Catholics obey This Word of God and can get the “keys to The Kingdom of Heaven” that The Son of God, David, and Mary gave His life to Speak Into Being on earth:

Question 2: “What let David defeat Goliath?”

Answer: “He identified the weak point in Goliath’s armor that left part of his forehead exposed.”

Question 3: “How did David take advantage of that?”

Answer: “King David’s first job was as a ‘shepherd’. He spent years taking care of his father’s sheep. Shepherds had a lot of time on their hands while the sheep were grazing. They used that time to practice throwing stones with their slings.”

Question 4: “Why did shepherds spend countless hours learning to use their slings effectively?”

Answer: “Shepherds needed food for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. David could see that the uncovered place on Goliath’s forehead was no bigger than the birds he needed to kill every day for food.”

Question 4: “How does the ‘stone’ of David help us understand the word ‘rock’ in The Church-Creating Word of Jesus: *‘And I say unto you thou art Peter and on this rock I build My Church and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. I give you the keys to The Kingdom of Heaven.’*?”

Answer: “Jesus wanted to let everyone on earth save our souls by getting the ‘keys to The Kingdom of Heaven’ that He died to leave on earth. To do that, Jesus had to have a ‘rock’ that was harder than a human head. His ‘rock’ hit His Chosen People with Catholic Teachings that would go through their unprotected foreheads.”

Question 5: “Was ‘the rock of Peter’ God’s ‘updated’ version of David’s ‘smooth stone’ that God chose throw against every ‘soldier of evil’ used by the devil to wage war on God’s people in every generation?”

Answer: “Peter and The Catholic Church are ‘God’s rock’. Catholic Teachings are the, ‘smooth stone’ with which God blesses billions of people to defeat the Deadly Sins. They loom like ‘Goliath’s in our mind every time they attack our mind and soul.”

Psalm 144:1 tells us why Catholics have this Response in Today’s Psalm: “*Blessed be The Lord, my rock, who trains my hands for battle, my fingers for war . . .*”

Mary said “Yes.” to God. May we all.

Question 1: “Why must every Catholic on earth suffer from ‘attacks’?”

Answer: “Today’s Reading from Psalm 56:2-3 tells us: *‘Have mercy on me, O God, for men trample upon me; all the day they press their attack against me. My adversaries trample upon me all the day; yes, many fight against me.’*”

Question 2: “How do Catholics respond to the ‘attacks’ against our life and soul?”

Answer: “We see television, newspapers, books, movies, and web pages. Nearly all of them are made to ‘attack’ Catholic Teachings that we strive to obey.”

Question 3: “What words does The Bible say we should follow when we are being ‘attacked’?”

Answer: “Catholics know that Jesus loves us! We make Today’s Response to the Daily Psalm: ‘In God I trust; I shall not fear.’”

Question 4: “What gives Catholics the courage to keep ‘fear’ from ‘trusting God’?”

Answer: “Today’s Reading includes 2 Timothy 1:10! *‘Our Savior Jesus Christ has destroyed death and brought life to light through The Gospel.’* His ‘light’ lets us see how to overcome ‘fear’ from those who ‘attack’ us.”

~

Question 5: “Where does ‘The Gospel’ let us see that Jesus has ‘brought life to light’?”

Answer: “In the second half of John, 6, Jesus tells us that He has ‘brought life to light’ with The Call to Catholic Communion He repeated 12 times: *‘If you do not eat My Body and drink My Blood you do not have life in you.’* Jesus repeated that two more times at The Last Supper.”

~

Question 6: “Why are Catholics blessed with ‘the light’ to see that that Jesus has ‘brought light to life’ by providing His Actual Body and Blood in Catholic Communion?”

Answer: “The names of every Catholic are written in The Book of Life we ‘see’ in Revelation 19:15. *‘And anyone whose name could not be written in The Book of Life was thrown into the burning lake.’*”

Catholics withstand the ‘attacks’ that keep our ‘names’ from ‘The Book of Life’.”


Question 7: “Does The Book of Revelation tell us that those with the ‘light of life’ will see God?”

Answer: “Revelation 22:5 explains the eternal reward of being Catholic! *‘It will never be night again and they will not need lamplight or sunlight because The Lord God will be shining on them and they will reign forever and ever.’*”

Catholics ask God to let us pray and work to have our names kept in God’s “Book of Life”. God’s “Light” lets us “see” that we must keep evil “attacks” from leading us to disobey Any Word of God.

How do Catholics live by God's Lesson to David and Saul three thousand years ago?



A thousand years before Jesus, God made “The Supreme Law of Scripture” very, very clear.

Question 1: “Today’s Reading is from 1 Samuel, 24:3-21. King Saul was so jealous of God’s Love for David that he led ‘3,000 picked soldiers’ to find and kill him. Did God give David the same message that Jesus gives to us: ‘Do good to them that hurt you. Love your neighbor as yourself.’?”

Answer: “The Book of James 2:8 tells us: *‘Well, the right thing to do is keep the Supreme Law of Scripture: ‘You must love your neighbor as yourself.’*” David obeyed The Supreme Law of Scripture by not killing Saul when he had the chance.”

Question 2: “Many of us people, families, and nations are like David. We are threatened by people who want to destroy us. Are we supposed to ‘love them as ourselves’?”

Answer: “Catholics see what Saul did and said when he realized that David had spared his life when he was in a cave ‘relieving himself’: First, ‘Saul wept aloud. Saul then said to David: “You are in the right rather than I; you have treated me generously, while I have done you harm. Great is the generosity you showed me today, when The Lord delivered me into your grasp and you did not kill me.”’”

~

Question 3: “What else did Saul say when he realized that God led David to spare his life?”

Answer: Saul said one of the more amazing things in Scripture to the man he tried to kill! *‘May The Lord rewarded you generously for what you have done this day.’*”

~

Question 4: “After Saul said that, what did God do?”

Answer: “God revealed This Prophetic Truth to Saul: *‘And now, I know that you shall surely be king and that sovereignty over Israel shall come into your possession.’*”

~

Question 5: Is God also Speaking That Word to every Catholic on earth?”

Answer: “If we ‘love our neighbors as ourselves’, we will have ‘sovereignty’ over ourselves. When we drive out the demons that keep us from loving our neighbors, we become ‘Kings’ of the ever-growing ‘world’ that is our mind.

Today’s Reading from 2 Corinthians 5:19 confirms that. *‘God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, and entrusting to us the message of reconciliation.’*”

When dealing with those who want to hurt us, Catholics strive to “Forgive and Forget.” The better we do that, the more “sovereignty” we have over the world in our mind. We are “reconciled’ with God and our beloved neighbors.
